Cooking with Krista

Satay Peanut Chicken Stir-fry

Krista is a Calgary chef and busy young mom, who believes that preparing, fast, tasty and healthy, home-cooked meals is within reach for today's active families. Krista has a soft spot in her heart for Deer Ridge, where she lived and played, while obtaining her Red Seal Chef Certificate from SAIT Culinary School.

This classic dish is quick and easy to prepare, and is always a hit with the family! You can be creative with the vegetables that you choose to add, and it can be served with white or brown rice, Asian noodles, or by itself. It'll be a big win if you have any peanut butter lovers in your house!

Ingredients:

8 boneless, skinless chicken thighs
1/2 cup peanut butter
1 tbs Maggi Seasoning (or soy sauce)
1 tbs hoisin sauce
Pinch of chili flakes
Salt and pepper
2 tbs cooking oil, divided
1 onion sliced
1 red pepper sliced
1/2 zucchini sliced
8 mushrooms quartered
1 broccoli crown
2 carrots sliced

Directions:

Set oven to low broil. Heat a large frying pan with one tbs of cooking oil. Dice and season chicken thighs with chili flakes, salt, and pepper, and sauté them in the hot pan until 3/4 cooked and browned on the outside.

In a small saucepan combine peanut butter, soy sauce and hoisin sauce. Heat on low, whisking until fully combined.

Place chicken on a baking sheet and pour sauce on top; place in oven under preheated broiler to lightly caramelize the sauce on the chicken.

Meanwhile, heat the other tablespoon of cooking oil in the pan you used earlier to cook the chicken, add all the vegetables, and sauté on high heat until halfway cooked. Pull the chicken and sauce out from the broiler and immediately add them to the vegetables. Sauté together for 2 minutes.

Serve right away on top of rice or rice noodles. For an additional touch of freshness, garnish with sliced green onions and sesame seeds.

Get Outside!

Skating

Deer Ridge has two well maintained skating rinks – a hockey rink and a pleasure rink. They're located by the community gardens, at the southwest end of the green space attached to Don Bosco School. The rinks are volunteer maintained, but these volunteers have many years of experience and some excellent ice grooming equipment. And there's no charge for you to use these rinks – all you need to bring is your skates, your energy, and your enthusiasm; so, bundle up and come out to have some fun on the ice!

Tobogganing and Sledding

Tobogganing and sledding have a long history of exciting winter fun for kids of all ages. I recall my dad taking us kids out to sledding hills where we would whoop and shriek on the long, exciting ride down, and then exhaust ourselves hauling the toboggan back up to the top. We always came home, all rosy cheeked, looking for hot chocolate and a warm dinner, having left all our pent up, winter energy behind on the hill. We slept especially well those nights, dreaming of flying down hills, cold air on our faces, and happy shouts about who got in the longest run.

I was pretty sure I could still find some of this exhilaration for my kids here in Calgary, and yes - did you know that the City website has quite a long list of parks and green spaces that offer safe, exciting hills for this winter tradition? We are so very lucky here in Deer Ridge. We're within walking distance of Fish Creek Park, where throughout the winter, there is most often good snow for snowshoeing, and cross-country skiing, and well-groomed paths for walking and hiking. Don't have the gear for

Swans? Here, in Calgary?

Did you know that in the early spring, before the snow is gone, usually sometime around early March (weather dependent), you can see swans in the river around Mallard Point? Either walk down to that end of the park, or drive and leave your car in the lot at the far east end of Canyon Meadows Drive, and follow the trail south along the river, to near the large bend. You'll need to be fairly quiet – the swans are quite wary of intruders and will stay far from you.


