


Calgary's warm season is so short, we need to get out into our yards to enjoy the sunshine, fresh air, and relaxation that time outside can bring. And who doesn't need that right now?

Community Garden

Another way to get outside and get some exercise is to get your hands dirty in the community garden. We are very excited to say that our Community Garden is open this year, and you are still welcome to join. Applications can be found online at <https://deerridgeca.com/community-gardens/>.

The City of Calgary will again be providing finished compost from the green cart composting program this year.

A community garden plot can provide fresh and tasty organic vegetables and greens, additional food security, and fewer trips to the grocery store. Healthy eating and savings – what's not to love? It's also great exercise and a great way to get to know your neighbours – at a distance this year. COVID-19 safety, physical distancing, and disinfection requirements are posted at the Community Gardens, and will be provided with your garden plot membership.

Cancellations/Postponements

Our tennis courts, lacrosse at the rink, and our playgrounds are not open this year, pursuant to City of Calgary regulations. Soccer at the Yellow Slide Park fields is also not happening. The June Parade of Garage Sales has been canceled, there will be no late June Community Festival, and the Deer Ridge Community Clean-Up has been canceled. When I look at this list of cancellations, I am suddenly reminded of what an active community we are – congratulations, Deer Ridge; keep up the good work! This is what makes a community!

Gardening/Landscaping at Home

Did you know that the City of Calgary provides free mulch to home gardeners? The mulch is created from Christmas trees that have been chipped. The mulch can be acidic in nature, so is not recommended for use around tender annuals, but is great for use around evergreens and garden displays. Calgarians can pick up as much as two truckloads from the East Calgary Landfill, at no charge, on a first come, first serve basis.

40 Years of Community!

Deer Ridge Community Association celebrates its 40th anniversary this year, although the lands for Deer Ridge were annexed as early as 1961. Prior to that, the lands were used for farming and ranching, and were a part of the Bow Valley Farm. 

CRIME STATISTICS

Deer Ridge Crime Activity was Down in April 2020

The Deer Ridge community experienced 1 crime in April 2020, in comparison to 4 crimes the previous month, and 12 crimes in April one year ago. Deer Ridge experiences an average of 4.3 crimes per month. On an annual basis, Deer Ridge experienced a total of 51 crimes as of April 2020, which is down 43% in comparison to 89 crimes as of April 2019. Did you know that the Deer Ridge Community Association is now 40 years old? The area we call home was once farming and ranch country, part of Patrick Burns' agricultural empire. The land for Deer Ridge was annexed by the City of Calgary in 1961, and Deer Ridge was established in 1978. The Deer Ridge Community Association soon followed, in 1980, bringing many more amenities and a sense of community to this new neighbourhood of tree lined streets, homes, gardens, and especially, families.

Cooking with Krista

Classic Chicken Pot Pie with Bacon and Mushrooms

Krista is a Calgary chef and busy young mom, who believes that preparing, fast, tasty and healthy, home-cooked meals is within reach for today's active families. Krista has a soft spot in her heart for Deer Ridge, where she lived and played, while obtaining her Red Seal Chef Certificate from SAIT Culinary School.

This is the dish that always makes me feel good all over. From a homemade flaky pie pastry, to the scrumptious bites of chicken and vegetables in a home cooked gravy. The smoky flavour of bacon and lots of fresh mushrooms really takes it up a notch.

This is a great weekend meal because it takes time and patience to get all of the ingredients just right, but if you nail it, I can guarantee you will get requests for this one all year long.

Pastry:

5 cups flour
1 tsp. baking powder
2 tsp. salt
3 tbs. brown sugar
1 lb. lard
1 cup cold water
2 tbs. white vinegar
1 egg beaten

Filling:

8 boneless skinless chicken thighs
Cooking oil
1/2 cup flour
1/2 onion diced
2 small carrots diced
2 celery stalks diced
4-5 mushrooms sliced
3-4 strips cooked bacon diced
1/2 cup frozen mixed veg with peas and corn
1/2 diced red pepper

2-3 bay leaves
1 litre chicken stock
Salt and pepper
Fresh thyme

Pastry Directions:

In a stand mixer, add all dry ingredients and mix on low until combined. Cut the lard into 1/2" cubes and add to dry mixture, mix only until lard looks like the size of peas in the flour mixture. Combine cold water, egg and vinegar, and sprinkle into lard mixture quickly, while mixing lightly until the dough just holds together, making sure to not over mix. Remove from bowl and gently knead into a ball. Cut into 2 pieces, wrap in Saran Wrap and place in fridge to cool down for at least 2 hours.

Once cooled, cut each pastry ball into 4. Roll each piece out on a floured surface and push into individual pie tins (about 1/4" thick). I trim the edges and roll the trimmings out to form the lid.

Filling Directions:

While your pastry is cooling in the fridge, you can make the chicken and bacon filling. I like to use my slow cooker for this because I can really get a great flavour profile by cooking it low and slow for several hours.

Dice chicken and place in very hot slow cooker (or pan) with cooking oil. Brown chicken meat and add flour, sauté the chicken for 2 minutes in the flour before adding the onion, carrot, celery mushrooms and seasoning. Once the vegetables are coated in the flour and chicken juices, slowly add the chicken stock until it is all combined. Let this cook in your slow cooker on high setting for 3-4 hours, season as necessary.

Since frozen vegetables and peppers tend to overcook easily, I add them to the stew with the bacon bits just before putting the mixture into the cooled pie shells. They will cook all the way through during the final step.

Scoop your stew mixture into your shells and use an egg wash to seal the lid to the base of the pie. Cut a small air hole in the centre of the lid and brush the top of the pies with the egg wash. Place pies in preheated oven 350 for one hour or until golden crispy on the top and sides.

Watch your whole family marvel at the beauty of breaking into a crispy homemade pie, watching the gravy and chicken roll onto the plate as the steam rises up into the air.

SAVE THE WOLVES

A lot of people think wolves will attack them. In the past, people were afraid wolves would attack their farm animals. Most hunters don't like wolves because they both hunt the same animals. However, adult wolves are usually scared of humans because humans are their only predator. Wolf cubs have predators like grizzly bears, cougars and even eagles.

Here are some cool facts about five different types of wolves:

Red wolves are endangered. There used to be more than 100,000 red wolves in the wild. As of April 2018, there were only about 40 red wolves left in the wild. Red wolves are actually brown, white, and they have a little bit of red on their face.

Grey wolves are the most common type of wolf in the whole world. There are a lot of different types of grey wolves. Australia's wild dog, which is called the dingo, is a subspecies of the grey wolf.

Another type of grey wolf is the Arctic wolf.

Arctic wolves have short legs and thick white fur, which helps them stay warm in their freezing habitat. Arctic wolves are smaller than ordinary grey wolves. One more type of grey wolf is the Mexican wolf.

Mexican wolves are the most endangered type of grey wolf in the world. In Spanish, the word for Mexican wolf is el lobo.

Black wolves are becoming more common in North America. Their black colored fur might have come from domestic dogs that mated with wolves.

It is hard to tell the difference between a coyote and a wolf, but coyotes have pointed ears and a small nose. Wolves have small, round ears. They are bigger and weigh twice as much as coyotes.

Here are some ways you could help save the wolves! There are wolf and wolf dog sanctuaries where you can donate. There are also places like zoos where you can donate or volunteer.
